Worthy Dog Robber Quarterly Report
January 2009

Dogs of Pennsylvania Pack,

I submit to you the following report for the 4th quarter of 2008:

- We added 12 new PUPs to the Pack this quarter, for a total of 15 so far this year.
- I still have not received installation reports from Pounds 31 and 107.
- 9 Dogs were reinstated in this quarter, for a total of 15 so far this year.
- 1 new Life Member this quarter.
- Year to Date we have \$40 big bones in credits due to several Pounds and a Stray for over payments received during the year.
- On January 1st, Kennel dropped 26 Dogs from the roll for not paying dues since 2007. 1 was reinstated since then and is included in the 9 this quarter. We need Pounds that have delinquent Dogs to make an effort to get these dogs back to paid-up status.
- There also seems to be some confusion as to the Dues and Fee structure for Pennsylvania Pack. We follow the same rules as Kennel, except for the yearly dues and reinstatement fee amounts. PA Pack dues are \$2.50 big bones and our reinstatement fee is \$1 big bone per year. So, for reinstatements a Dog must pay the current year dues plus up to 3 years of past dues and reinstatement fees. The 3 reinstatement scenarios be as follows:
 - 1) If a Dog has been delinquent for 3 or more years (last paid for 2005 or before) the dues would be \$10 (current year plus the maximum 3 delinquent years) and the reinstatement fee would be \$3 big bone for a total of \$13 big bones.
 - 2) If a Dog has been delinquent for 2 years (last paid for 2006) the dues would be \$7.50 (current plus the 2 delinquent years) and the reinstatement fee would be \$2 big bone for a total of \$9.50 big bones.
 - 3) If a Dog has been delinquent for 1 year (last paid for 2007) the dues would be \$5.00 (current plus the 1 delinquent year) and the reinstatement fee would be \$1 big bone for a total of \$6.00 big bones.
- For those Pounds that have not had elections and installation yet, please be aware that to be in compliance with Kennel Bylaws you should have held your elections and installations by November 13, 2008. The Bylaw is as follows:

Section 205 - Growls - Regular, Annual, Special and Staff

A. REGULAR - Each Pound shall hold no less than four regular assemblies during any fiscal year, which assemblies shall include the annual assembly of the Pound, for the election of officers.

B. ANNUAL - Each Pound shall hold one annual assembly to be held during the three months following the month of the Supreme Growl of the Kennel. This assembly may be one of the regular assemblies specified in Paragraph A, above, and shall be designated a Growl of the Pound. At this annual Growl of the Pound the full order of business shall be called and acted upon, including the nomination, election and installation of Officers, and at which Growl the outgoing officers shall make full and proper reports and accounting to the Pound. The Installation Report for the new officers shall be submitted to the Honorable Kennel Dog Robber no later than the end of the month immediately following the Growl. The Installation Report shall be submitted via the Worthy Pack Dog Robber, if there is such, and a copy shall be sent to the respective Division Vice Chief Devil Dog.
